Shattuck-St. Mary's is a selective, independent boarding and day school enrolling 409 students in grades six through twelve and the postgraduate program. Students currently come from 37 states and 28 countries; twenty five percent are from Minnesota. The comprehensive fee is \$39,950 and 45 percent of students receive need and/or merit-based financial assistance. The teaching faculty, including full and part time instructors, numbers sixty nine with one third holding masters degrees or doctorates. The average class size is eleven. Shattuck-St. Mary's is accredited by the Independent Schools Association of the Central States (ISACS) and holds membership in the following: College Entrance Examination Board, Educational Records Bureau, The *Cum Laude* Society, National Association of Episcopal Schools, National Association of Independent Schools.

Academic Program and Graduation Requirements

The curriculum is college preparatory and includes approximately one hundred courses. The school year consists of three terms averaging twelve weeks each. A student must complete the following minimum requirements in grades 9-12 either at Shattuck-St. Mary's or another institution. The minimum course load is five courses per term.

Additional One-Term Courses: Ethics, Academic Seminar, Private Music Lessons, Independent Study.

Performing Arts: The performing arts at Shattuck-St. Mary's School represent significant curricular and co-curricular offerings. Our pre-conservatory programs (Strings and Vocal Performance), each represent major time commitments and meet for a double period each class day. Students in these offerings invest time equivalent to an advanced placement course.

Grade Point Average: A student's grade point average (GPA) is calculated at the end of each term and at the end of each academic year. Shattuck-St. Mary's uses a traditional 4.0=A scale and all graded courses are used in calculating the GPA. Advanced Placement courses are weighted 1.1.

Class Rank: At Shattuck-St. Mary's School virtually all graduates enter four year institutions and therefore rank in class is not considered a strong predictor of college performance. Class rank is not calculated and is reported with the designation N/A on secondary school reports.
