Team Synchronized Team Development

- > 7.5 months of training and competition (August March) with a mandatory boot camp week in August
- Synchronized Competitive Season: 5-6 events, including registration, practice, travel, hotel, apparel, ice time, coaching fee and meal stipend (air flight excluded)
- ➤ Synchronized Team Practice: 3-4 days per week (1.5 2 hours per), appropriate ratio of training to competition
- Exhibitions, Ice Shows, Competitions and Clinics

Freestyle Competition Development

- On-going skater evaluation, assessments, and goal setting
- Approximately 5 competitions during the school year; including registration, practice, travel, hotel, apparel, ice time, coaching fee and meal stipend (air flight excluded)
- Exhibitions, Ice Shows, Competitions and Clinics
- Approximately 3 to 4 USFS test sessions during school year
- > Team uniform for all new students

Weekly Figure Skating Training

- Warm-up and Edge Class / Cool Down and Stretch Following
